Just so everyone is on the same page, below is a description of a current program designed to help improve the health care veterans receive.

In 2014, President Obama and Congress enacted the VA Choice Act to give veterans the ability to seek care outside of VA medical facilities. This legislation was intended to help alleviate delayed care that came to public view as a result of an enormous scandal involving wait time cover-ups—and potentially thousands of subsequent veteran deaths—at more than 100 VA facilities around the country.

Under this bill, veterans can seek health care outside the VA if they live more than 40 miles away from the nearest VA medical facility or if they cannot get an appointment from their local VA facility within 30 days.

Additionally, medical facilities outside the VA must be approved by the VA to give care, and the VA is responsible for scheduling all appointments for veterans at outside facilities.

With a few slight modifications, President Trump re-signed this legislation into law and eliminated the expiration date that would have ended the program later this year.
