BIOGRAPHY

John Vick is executive director of Concerned Veterans for America and a veteran of the United States Marine Corps and Navy.

John enlisted in the Marine Corps in 2003 and served in al-Anbar, Iraq. After four years in the Corps, he attended the U.S. Naval Academy and then served in the Navy Reserves as an officer.

During his time in the Navy, John served two deployments in support of Operation Inherent Resolve where he assisted in planning over 70 special operations within the Horn of Africa and supervised an operation department across Navy SEAL and Marine Raider teams. He continues to serve in the Navy Reserves as an intelligence officer supporting U.S. Central Command.

John's service has earned him two Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and numerous unit, campaign, and service medals. In addition to graduating from the Naval Academy, he holds a degree in Defense and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College and a graduate credential in Business Administration from Harvard Business School.
